Daily Market Report



Monday September 28, 2020

All sectors closed in the green zone...ASI surged by 72 Basis Points

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed bullish as the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) increased by 0.72% from 26,319.34 to close at **26,507.84**. Market Capitalization increased by N98 billion to close at N13.85 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) closed at **-1.25%** from -1.95%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's bullish market can be largely attributed to buy interests recorded in large and mid-cap stocks across Oil and Gas, Consumer Goods, Banking and Insurance. Some of today's market gainers include Total (10.00%), Champion (9.88%), Oando (9.85%), Aiico (9.72%), Intbrew (8.33%), Wapco (6.31%), Buacement (4.80%), Fbnh (3.88%) and Sterlnbank (2.59%) among others.

Sectors performance was significantly bullish

Performance across sectors was significantly bullish. All five sectors closed in the green zone today; Oil & Gas, Insurance, Consumer Goods, Industrial and Banking indices increased by 1.33%, 1.02%, 0.53%, 0.53% and 0.26% respectively, owing to buy interests recorded in the shares of Total (10.00%) and Oando (9.85%); Mbenefit (5.00%) and Chiplc (8.82%); Champion (9.88%) and Intbrew (8.33%); Wapco (6.31%) and Buacement (4.80%); Fbnh (3.88%) and Ubn (3.00%) amongst others.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume improved by 0.32%, however value declined by -5.80%. Investors traded a total of 336 million units of shares valued at N4.02 billion in 4,602 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was positive as it closed at 3.14x indicating a bullish mood. At the close of trading, **Total (10.00%)**, **Champion (9.88%)**, **Oando (9.85%)**, **Aiico (9.72%)**, **Chiplc (8.82%)**, **Intbrew (8.33%)**, **Wapco (6.31%)**, **Mbenefit (5.00%)**, **Buacement (4.80%)** and **Uacn (4.10%)** were among the 22 market gainers, while; **Uac-Prop (-10.00%)**, **Upl (-6.34%)**, **Caverton (-5.98%)**, **Maybaker (-5.54%)**, **Wemabank (-3.64%)**, **Jaizbank (-3.39%)** and **Seplat (-0.50%)** were among the 7 market laggards. However, 73 stock prices remained unchanged.

Banking emerged as the most active sector. Equities of **SterInbank, Zenithbank** and **Uba** were the most active in the subsector as 235 million units of shares worth N2.35 billion were traded in 1829 transactions. Equities of **SterInbank, Zenithbank** and **Uba** accounted for 87% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Conglomerates. Equities of **Fcmb** and **Fbnh** were the most active in the subsector as 42.23 million units of shares worth N119 million were traded in 508 transactions. Trading in the Equities of **Fcmb** and **Fbnh** accounted for 83% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market was bullish after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) increased by 0.07% to **733.11**. Consequently, Market Capitalization improved by 0.07% to N538.52 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume surged by 645.68% while value increased by 508.40%. Investors traded a total of 37,284 units of shares valued at N4,182,747.34 in 7 deals. Three securities traded on the USI today, namely; Wamco Plc, UBN prop and CSCS Plc.


