Equity market Closes on Bullish NoteASI Gains 11 Basis Point

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed positive as bulls dominated proceedings in the market today. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) appreciated by 0.11% to close at 40,341.05. Similarly, Market Capitalization increased by N23 billion to close at N21.09 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 0.17%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's positive market direction can be largely attributed to gains recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in the Insurance, Oil and Gas, Banking, Industrial and Consumer goods sector. Some of today's market advancers include: MANSARD (9.52%), JAPAUL (9.48%), MOBIL (9.43%), FLOURMILL(6.93%), GUINNESS (1.61%), ARDOVA (1.52%), WAPCO (1.35%), ACCESS (1.10%), ZENITH (0.39%) and SEPLAT (0.08%) amongst others.

Sectors performance was Significantly Bullish

Performance across sectors was significantly bullish as all 5 sectors closed in the green zone. Insurance, Oil and Gas, Banking, Industrial, and Consumer Goods indices advanced by 4.12%, 1.74%, 0.08% and 0.11% respectively, on the back of buy interests recorded in the shares MANSARD (9.52%), JAPAUL (9.48%), MOBIL (9.43%), FLOURMILL(6.93%), GUINNESS (1.61%), ARDOVA (1.52%), WAPCO (1.35%), ACCESS (1.10%), ZENITH (0.39%) and SEPLAT (0.08%) among others.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 59.86% while value decreased by 12.63%. Investors traded a total of 468 million units of shares valued at N6.96 billion in 5,697 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners closed positive at 2.00x indicating a bullish mood. At the close of trading: MANSARD (9.52%), JAPAUL (9.48%), MOBIL (9.43%), FLOURMILL(6.93%), GUINNESS (1.61%), ARDOVA (1.52%), WAPCO (1.35%), ACCESS (1.10%), ZENITH (0.39%) and SEPLAT (0.08%) were amongst the 32 market gainers, while LIVESTOCK (-9.74%), FTNCOCOA (-5.88%), CUTIX (-5.00%), INTBREW (-3.82%), AFRIPRUD (-2.59%), ETI (-1.54%), TRANSCORP (-1.04%), FIDELITY (-0.74%), FBNH (-0.68%) and GUARANTY (-0.31%)were amongst the 16 market laggards. 58 stock prices remained unchanged.

The Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of Zenith, UBA and Guaranty were the most active in the subsector as 95 million units of shares worth N2.06 billion were traded in 1141 transactions. Equities of Sterling, Fidelity and Zenith accounted for 72% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS were the most active in the subsector as 34 million units of shares worth N120 million were traded in 271 transactions. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS accounted for 55% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed flat after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) remained unchanged to close at 740.98. Consequently, Market Capitalization also remained unchanged to close at N531.67. Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 97.09% while value increased by 150.11%. Investors traded a total of 47,544units of shares valued at N4.9 mn in 2 deals.


