Equity market Closes on Bullish NoteASI Gains 154 Basis Point

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed positive as bulls dominated proceedings in the market today. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) appreciated by 1.54% to close at 40,963.14. Similarly, Market Capitalization increased by N325 billion to close at N21.42 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 1.72%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's positive market direction can be largely attributed to gains recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in the Insurance, Oil and Gas, Banking, Industrial and Consumer goods sector. Some of today's market advancers include: MANSARD (9.42%), ARDOVA (9.25%), WAPCO (3.98%), ACCESS (3.83%), DANGSUGAR (3.56%), DANGCEM (3.04%), UBA (2.84%), FLOURMILL (2.39%), FBNH (2.04%), ZENITH (1.93%) and GUARANTY (1.85%) amongst others.

Sectors performance was Significantly Bullish

Performance across sectors was significantly bullish as all 5 sectors closed in the green zone. Insurance, Oil and Gas, Banking, Industrial, and Consumer Goods indices advanced by 4.12%, 1.74%, 0.08% and 0.11% respectively, on the back of buy interests recorded in the shares MANSARD (9.42%), ARDOVA (9.25%), WAPCO (3.98%), ACCESS (3.83%), DANGSUGAR (3.56%), DANGCEM (3.04%), UBA (2.84%), FLOURMILL (2.39%), FBNH (2.04%), ZENITH (1.93%) and GUARANTY (1.85%) among others.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 72.89% while value increased by 2|7.89%. Investors traded a total of 809 million units of shares valued at N8.91 billion in 6,706 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners closed positive at 7.00x indicating a bullish mood. At the close of trading: MANSARD (9.42%), ARDOVA (9.25%), WAPCO (3.98%), ACCESS (3.83%), DANGSUGAR (3.56%), DANGCEM (3.04%), UBA (2.84%), FLOURMILL (2.39%), FBNH (2.04%), ZENITH (1.93%) and GUARANTY (1.85%) were amongst the 49 market gainers, while COURTVILLE (-8.33%), NEIMETH (-6.36%), UNIONDAC (-3.13%), JAIZ (-2.78%), JOHNHOLT (-1.96%), NAHCO (-1.75%) and GUINNESS (-0.26%) the 7 market laggards. 57 stock prices remained unchanged.

The Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of Zenith, Access and Guaranty were the most active in the subsector as 139 million units of shares worth N3.64 billion were traded in 1417 transactions. Equities of Zenith, Access and Guaranty accounted for 67% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS were the most active in the subsector as 58 million units of shares worth N332 million were traded in 325 transactions. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS accounted for 69% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) as it advanced by 0.07% to close at 741.47. Consequently, Market Capitalization also closed positive to close at N53202. Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 26.38% while value decreased by 7.19%. Investors traded a total of 35,000 units of shares valued at N4.56 mn in 9 deals.


