Equities market Closes on a Negative NoteASI Loses 23 Basis Point

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed negative as bears dominated proceedings in the market today. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.23% to close at 41,082.38. Similarly, Market Capitalization decreased by N39 billion to close at N21.49 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 2.02%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's negative market direction can be largely attributed to loses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in the Industrial and Consumer goods sector. Some of today's market decliners include: JAPAUL (-6.58%), FLOURMILL (-5.49%), FBNH (-3.95%), FIDELITY (-1.81%), UBA (-1.62%), DANGSUGAR (-1.44%), ACCESS (-1.03%), DANGCEM (-1.01%), FCMB (-0.93%) and ZENITH (-0.57%) amongst others.

Sectors performance was Broadly Bullish

Performance across sectors was broadly bullish as 3 out of the 5 sectors closed in the green zone. Insurance, Banking and Oil and Gas indices advanced by 5.93%, 0.01% and 0.02% respectively, on the back of buy interests recorded in the shares CADBURY (10.00%), LIVESTOCK (9.95%), TRANSCORP (9.18%), MANSARD (5.62%), GUARANTY (1.82%), UACN (1.21%), VITAFOAM (1.10%), WAPCO (0.84%), ETI (0.77%) and OANDO (0.29%) among others. While Industrial (-0.43%) and Consumer Goods (-0.62%) indices closed in the red zone due to sell pressure in the shares of JAPAUL (-6.58%), FLOURMILL (-5.49%), FBNH (-3.95%), FIDELITY (-1.81%), UBA (-1.62%), DANGSUGAR (-1.44%), ACCESS (-1.03%), DANGCEM (-1.01%), FCMB (-0.93%) and ZENITH (-0.57%) amongst others.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 10.79% while value decreased by 34.76%. Investors traded a total of 738 million units of shares valued at N4.17 billion in 7,396 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners closed positive at 1.6x indicating a bullish mood. At the close of trading: CADBURY (10.00%), LIVESTOCK (9.95%), TRANSCORP (9.18%), MANSARD (5.62%), GUARANTY (1.82%), UACN (1.21%), VITAFOAM (1.10%), WAPCO (0.84%), ETI (0.77%) and OANDO (0.29%) were amongst the 35 market gainers, while JAPAUL (-6.58%), FLOURMILL (-5.49%), FBNH (-3.95%), FIDELITY (-1.81%), UBA (-1.62%), DANGSUGAR (-1.44%), ACCESS (-1.03%), DANGCEM (-1.01%), FCMB (-0.93%) and ZENITH (-0.57%) were among the 22 market laggards. 55 stock prices remained unchanged.

The Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of Fidelity, Access and Zenith were the most active in the subsector as 101 million units of shares worth N1.23 billion were traded in 1060 transactions. Equities of Fidelity, Access and Zenith accounted for 63% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS were the most active in the subsector as 60 million units of shares worth N303million were traded in 337 transactions. Equities of FBNH and VERITAS accounted for 68% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) as it advanced by 0.60% to close at 744.46. Consequently, Market Capitalization also closed positive to close at N534.16. Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 208.61% while value decreased by 4.09%. Investors traded a total of 10.01mn units of shares valued at N10.76 mn in 2 deals.



Nigeria's inflation rate spikes by 15.75% in December 2020, highest in 3 years

Nigeria's inflation rate increased by 15.75% (year-on-year) in December 2020, the highest rate recorded in 3 years. On a month-on-month basis, the index increased by 1.61% in December 2020. This is 0.01% point higher than the rate recorded in November 2020 (1.60%).
