## Equities market continues Trading week on a Negative Note...ASI Loses 19 Basis Point

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed negative as bears dominated proceedings in the market today. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.19% to close at 40,494.35. Similarly, Market Capitalization decreased by N41 billion to close at N21.18 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 0.56%.

#### What shaped today's market direction?

Today's negative market direction can be largely attributed to loses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in the Insurance, Banking and Consumer goods sector. Some of today's market decliners include: CHIPLC (-10.00%), WAPIC (-8.33%), LINKASSU (-5.08%), STANBIC (-4.44%), NB (-3.28%), NASCON (-0.93%), FBNH (-0.68%), ZENITH (-0.60%), ACCESS (-0.59%) and UBA (-0.58%) among others.

#### Sectors performance was Broadly Bearish

Performance across sectors was broadly bearish as 3 out of the 5 sectors closed in the red zone. Insurance, Banking and Consumer goods indices declined by 1.54%, 0.31% and 0.52% respectively, on the back of sell pressure recorded in the shares of CHIPLC (-10.00%), WAPIC (-8.33%), LINKASSU (-5.08%), STANBIC (-4.44%), NB (-3.28%), NASCON (-0.93%), FBNH (-0.68%), ZENITH (-0.60%), ACCESS (-0.59%) and UBA (-0.58%) among others. While Oil and gas and Industrial indices advanced on the back of buy interests in the shares of ARDOVA (5.74%), CAP (5.56%), OANDO (3.45%) and SEPLAT (0.83%).

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 75.75% while value increased by 170.97%. Investors traded a total of 356 million units of shares valued at N5.76 billion in 5,040 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was positive as it closed at 1.21x indicating a bullish mood. At the close of trading: ARDOVA (5.74%), CAP (5.56%), GUINNESS (4.88%), AFRIPRUD (4.51%), OANDO (3.45%), UACN (1.91%), FIDELITY (1.64%), SEPLAT (0.83%), GUARANTY (0.49%) and DANGSUGAR (0.26%) were the 23 market gainers, while CHIPLC (-10.00%), WAPIC (-8.33%), LINKASSU (-5.08%), STANBIC (-4.44%), NB (-3.28%), NASCON (-0.93%), FBNH (-0.68%), ZENITH (-0.60%), ACCESS (-0.59%) and UBA (-0.58%) were amongst the 19 market laggards. 60 stock prices remained unchanged.

The Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of Zenith, Guaranty and UBA were the most active in the subsector as 76 million units of shares worth N2.00 billion were traded in 1029 transactions. Equities of Zenith, Guaranty and UBA accounted for 78% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of FBNH and FCMB were the most active in the subsector as 37 million units of shares worth N240 million were traded in 289 transactions. Trading in the Equities of FBNH and FCMB accounted for 70% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

#### **NASD Market**

The NASD market closed positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) increased by 0.24% to close at 740.34. Consequently, Market Capitalization also closed positive at N531.20 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 538.37% while value increased by 19.04%. Investors traded a total of 635,707 units of shares valued at N8.91mn in 8 deals.


