Equities market closes on a Flat note ...ASI Loses 1 Basis Point

The Nigerian Stock Exchange (NSE) closed flat as bears dominated proceedings in the market today. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.01% to close at 38,324.07. Similarly, Market Capitalization decreased by 2 billion to close at N19.95 trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at -4.83%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's flat market direction can be largely attributed to losses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in Banking, Oil and gas and Industrial sector. Some of today's market decliners include: **CHAMS (-9.09%), JBERGER (-9.05%), OANDO (-3.33%), PZ (-1.85%), FIDELITY (-1.72%), AIICO (-1.55%), GUARANTY (-0.85%), ACCESS (-0.60%), UCAP (-0.33%) and BUACEMENT (-0.20%) amongst others.**

Sectors performance was Broadly Bearish

Performance across sectors was broadly bearish as 3 out of 5 sectors closed in the red zone. Banking, Oil and gas and Industrial indices declined by 0.25%, 0.26% and 0.09% respectively, on the back of sell pressures recorded in the shares of **CHAMS (-9.09%), JBERGER (-9.05%), OANDO (-3.33%), PZ (-1.85%), FIDELITY (-1.72%), AIICO (-1.55%), GUARANTY (-0.85%), ACCESS (-0.60%), UCAP (-0.33%) and BUACEMENT (-0.20%) amongst others.** While Consumer goods and Insurance Indices advanced by 0.04% and 1.19% respectively, on the back of buy interests in the shares of **WAPIC (8.00%), MBENEFIT (4.76%), TRANSCORP (2.66%), MANSARD (1.12%) and DANGSUGAR (0.58%).**

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 10.84% while value increased by 12.22%. Investors traded a total of 174 million units of shares valued at N1.95 billion in 2,581 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was negative as it closed at 1.00x indicating a flat mood. At the close of trading : **WAPIC (8.00%), NPFMCRRFBK (7.23%), STERLING (7.05%), MBENEFIT (4.76%), TRANSCORP (2.66%), STANBIC (1.55%), UACN (1.44%), MANSARD (1.12%), FBNH (0.69%) and DANGSUGAR (0.58%)** were the amongst 16 market gainers, while **CHAMS (-9.09%), JBERGER (-9.05%), OANDO (-3.33%), PZ (-1.85%), FIDELITY (-1.72%), AIICO (-1.55%), GUARANTY (-0.85%), ACCESS (-0.60%), UCAP (-0.33%) and BUACEMENT (-0.20%) amongst others** were amongst the 16 market laggards. 70 stock prices remained unchanged.

The Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of UBA, Access and Guaranty were the most active in the subsector as 19 million units of shares worth N337 million were traded in 482 transactions. Equities of UBA, Access and Guaranty accounted for 66% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of FBNH and VERITASKAP were the most active in the subsector as 15 million units of shares worth N63 million were traded in 118 transactions. Trading in the Equities of FBNH and VERITASKAP accounted for 68% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) increased by 1.25% to close at 773.99. Consequently, Market Capitalization also closed positive at N549.74 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 19.46% while value decreased by 10.83%. Investors traded a total of 3,021,423 units of shares valued at N72.68 million in 38 deals.

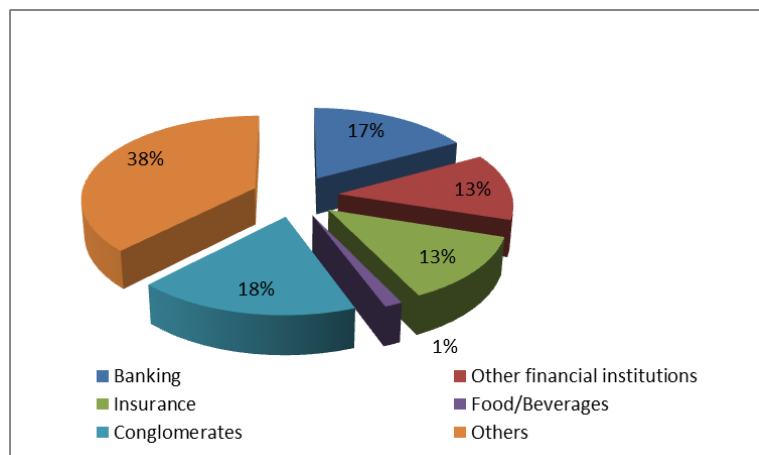

❖ FBNH Plc. Posts 32.50% PAT Decline in Q1'2021

FBNH Plc Q1'2021 results showed a decrease in the bottom-line as profit for the period declined by 32.50%. Similarly, Profit before tax fell by 34.08% from N28.68 bn in Q1'2020 to N18.91bn in the current period. Profit after tax went down by 32.50 % from N23.14 bn in Q1'2020 to N15.62 bn in the current period.
