Equities market closes on a Negative note... ASI loses 36 Basis Point

The Nigerian Exchange Limited (NGX) closed Negative. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.36% to close at 43,549.28. Market Capitalization decreased by 82.46 Billion to close at N22.73trillion while the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 8.14%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's market direction can be largely attributed to losses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in Banking, Industrial, Consumer Goods and Oil & Gas. Some of today's market losers include: ETRANZACT (-7.32%), STERLNBANK (-3.23%), UBA (-2.40%), ETI (-2.31%), NGXGROUP (-2.16%), WEMABANK (-1.15%), FIDELITYBK (-1.11%), UCAP (-1.02%), GTCO (-0.90%), ACCESS (-0.53%), MTNN (-0.50%) and ZENITHBANK (-0.41%) amongst others.

Sectors performance was Broadly Bearish.

Performance across sectors was broadly bearish as 4 out of 5 sectors closed in the red zone. Banking, Industrial, Consumer Goods and Insurance indices declined by 0.95%, 0.10%, 0.45% and 0.93% respectively. While Oil & Gas Index remained unchanged.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 40.41% while value decreased by 61.97%. Investors traded a total of 161 million units of shares valued at 2.14 billion in 3,574 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was Negative as it closed at 0.63x indicating a Bearish mood. At the close of UNITYBNK (7.27%), WAPCO (2.62%), UACN (2.33%), PZ (1.67%), AFRIPRUD (0.79%), FCMB (0.66%) and FBNH (0.44%), were amongst the 12 market gainers ETRANZACT (-7.32%), STERLNBANK (-3.23%), UBA (-2.40%), ETI (-2.31%), NGXGROUP (-2.16%), WEMABANK (-1.15%), FIDELITYBK (-1.11%), UCAP (-1.02%), GTCO (-0.90%), ACCESS (-0.53%), MTNN (-0.50%) and ZENITHBANK (-0.41%) amongst others were the 19 market laggards. 74 stock prices remained unchanged.

Other Financial Institutions emerged as the most active sector. Equities of FBNH, GTCO and UCAP were the most active in the subsector as 47 million units of shares worth N654.31 Million were traded in 1,580 transactions. FBNH, GTCO and UCAP accounted for 78% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Banking sector came second ahead of Conglomerates. Equities of ZENITHBANK and ACCESS were the most active in the subsector as 41 million units of shares worth N452 Million were traded in 1,583 transactions. Trading in the Equities of ZENITHBANK and ACCESS accounted for 52% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed Positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) increased by 0.59% to close at 757.16. Consequently, Market Capitalization closed at 625.55 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 292.50% while value increased by 485.36%. Investors traded a total of 222.154 units of shares valued at N5.69 million in 15 deals.


