NGX All Share Index closes on a Negative note... ASI loses 40 Basis Points

The Nigerian Exchange Limited Bourse closed Negative. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.40% to close at 51,586.50 pts. Market Capitalization decreased by 110.49 billion to close at N27.81 trillion and the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 20.76%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's market direction can be largely attributed to losses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in Banking, Industrial and Consumer Goods. Some of today's market losers include, INTBREW (-9.52%), NASCON (-6.38%), BUAFOODS (-6.36%), FCMB (-6.36%), FBNH (-5.63%), ZENITHBANK (-2.04%), AIICO (-1.56%) and STERLNBANK (-1.32%) amongst others.

Sectors performance was Broadly Bearish.

Performance across sectors was broadly bearish as 3 out of 5 sectors closed in the red zone. Banking, Consumer Goods and Insurance Indices declined by 0.53%, 0.58% and 0.48% respectively. Industrial Index advanced by 0.01%. While Oil/Gas Index remained unchanged.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 20.85% and value decreased by 8.95%. Investors traded a total of 234 million units of shares valued at N2.57 billion in 4,646 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was Positive as it closed at 1.44x indicating a Bullish mood. At the close of trading, REDSTAREX (10.00%), UNITYBNK (9.52%), NAHCO (6.25%), CADBURY (3.64%), PZ (1.96%), ACCESSCORP (1.61%), TRANSCORP (0.81%) and WAPCO (0.38%) were amongst the 23 market gainers INTBREW (-9.52%), NASCON (-6.38%), BUAFOODS (-6.36%), FCMB (-6.36%), FBNH (-5.63%), ZENITHBANK (-2.04%), AIICO (-1.56%) and STERLNBANK (-1.32%) amongst others were the 16 market laggards. 68 stock prices remained unchanged.

Banking emerged as the most active sector. Equities of STERLNBANK, UBA and ZENITHBANK were the most active in the subsector as 61 million units of shares worth N493.5 million were traded in 1,632 transactions. Trading in the Equities of STERLNBANK, UBA and ZENITHBANK accounted for 87% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions sector came second ahead of Conglomerates. Equities of GTCO and JAIZBANK were the most active in the subsector as 58 million units of shares worth N786.19 million were traded in 2,136 transactions. Trading in the Equities of GTCO and JAIZBANK accounted for 66% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed Positive after today's trading activities as the Unlisted Securities Index (USI) advanced by 0.05% to close at 773.89 pts. Consequently, Market Capitalization closed at 1.019 trillion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 4,905% and value increased by 5,976%. Investors traded a total of 535,515 units of shares valued at N33.35 million in 27 deals.


