NGX All Share Index closes on a Positive note... ASI Gains 25 Basis Points

The Nigerian Exchange Limited Bourse closed Positive. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) appreciated by 0.25% to close at 48,675.24 pts. Market Capitalization increased by 64.99 billion to close at N26.25 trillion and the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 13.95%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's market direction can be largely attributed to gains recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in Banking, Oil/Gas and Industrial. Some of today's market gainers include, **NEM (10.00%)**, **STANBIC (8.93%)**, **ETI (8.00%)**, **MBENEFIT (6.90%)**, **HONYFLOUR (2.77%)**, **STERLN BANK (1.33%)**, **BUACEMENT (1.27%)**, and **NESTLE (0.23%)** amongst others.

Sectors performance was Broadly Bullish.

Performance across sectors was broadly bullish as 5 out of 5 sectors closed in the green zone. Banking, Consumer Goods, Industrial, Insurance and Oil/Gas indices advanced by 0.56%, 0.09%, 0.47%, 2.17% and 0.16% respectively.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 17.92% and value increased by 5.98%. Investors traded a total of 168 million units of shares valued at N3.37 billion in 3,751 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was Positive as it closed at 1.45x indicating a Bullish mood. At the close of trading, **NEM (10.00%)**, **STANBIC (8.93%)**, **ETI (8.00%)**, **MBENEFIT (6.90%)**, **HONYFLOUR (2.77%)**, **STERLN BANK (1.33%)**, **BUACEMENT (1.27%)**, and **NESTLE (0.23%)** were amongst the 16 market gainers **FIDSON (-9.80%)**, **FCMB (-2.19%)**, **AIICO (-1.79%)**, **ACCESSCORP (-1.20%)**, **UBA (-0.71%)**, **GTCO (-0.50%)** and **UCAP (-0.42%)** were amongst others were the 11 market laggards. 73 stock prices remained unchanged.

Other Financial Institutions emerged as the most active sector. Equities of ACCESSCORP, FBNH and GTCO were the most active in the subsector as 77 million units of shares worth N911.10 million were traded in 1850 transactions. Trading in the Equities of ACCESSCORP, FBNH and GTCO accounted for 87% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Banking sector came second ahead of Insurance. Equities of UBA and ZENITHBANK were the most active in the subsector as 42 million units of shares worth N436.09 million were traded in 1,199 transactions. Trading in the Equities of UBA and ZENITHBANK accounted for 84% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market declined after today's trading activities as the NASD Security Index (NSI) decreased by 0.95% to close at 750.18 pts. Consequently, Market Capitalization closed at 987.55 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 17.73% and value increased by 100.17%. Investors traded a total of 126,600 units of shares valued at N13.34 million in 8 deals.

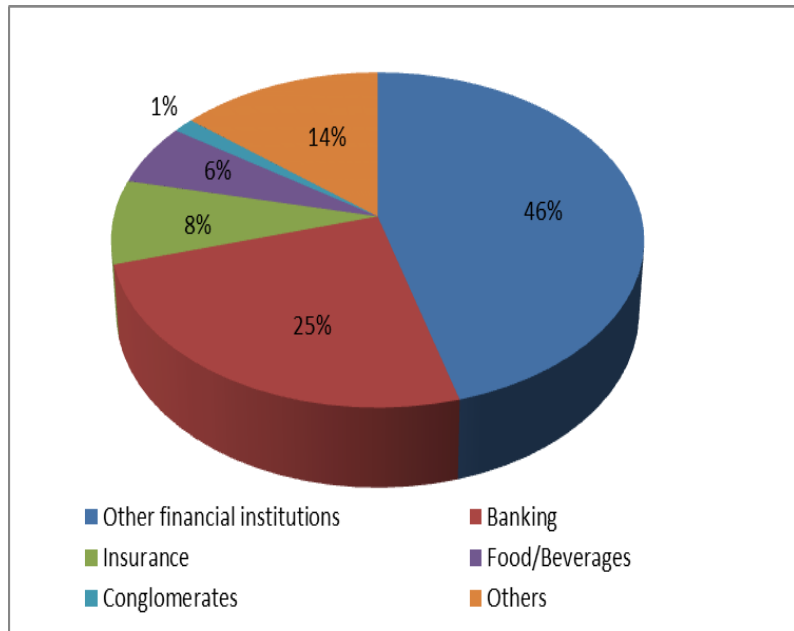
