NGX All Share Index closes on a Negative note... ASI Loses 10 Basis Points

The Nigerian Exchange Limited Bourse closed Negative. The benchmark All Share Index (ASI) depreciated by 0.10% to close at 49,575.93 pts. Market Capitalization decreased by 27.93 million to close at N26.74 trillion and the Year-to-Date (YtD) returns settled at 16.06%.

What shaped today's market direction?

Today's market direction can be largely attributed to losses recorded in large and mid-cap stocks in Banking, Oil/Gas and Industrial. Some of today's market losers include, **FTNCOCOA (-9.38%), AIICO (-3.51%), ZENITHBANK (-2.50%), NGXGROUP (-1.75%), UBA (-1.33%), ETI (-0.45%), FIDELITYBK (-0.29%) and GTCO (-0.25%)** amongst others.

Sectors performance was Broadly Bearish.

Performance across sectors was broadly bearish as 4 out of 5 sectors closed in the red zone. Banking, Consumer Goods, Industrial and Insurance Indices declined by 1.32%, 0.02%, 0.01% and 1.09% respectively. While Oil/Gas Index remained unchanged.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume increased by 23.22% and value increased by 97.76%. Investors traded a total of 197 million units of shares valued at N2.94 billion in 3,462 deals.

Market breadth measured by Advancers/Decliners was Negative as it closed at 0.78x indicating a Bearish mood. At the close of trading **REGALINS (8.00%), JAPAUFGOLD (3.70%), HONYFLOUR (3.00%), UNITYBANK (2.38%), JAIZBANK (1.19%), FCMB (0.94%), STERLNBANK (0.67%) and ACCESSCORP (0.56%)** were amongst the 14 market gainers **FTNCOCOA (-9.38%), AIICO (-3.51%), ZENITHBANK (-2.50%), NGXGROUP (-1.75%), UBA (-1.33%), ETI (-0.45%), FIDELITYBK (-0.29%) and GTCO (-0.25%)** were amongst others were the 18 market laggards. 70 stock prices remained unchanged.

Banking sector emerged as the most active sector. Equities of ZENITHBANK, STERLNBANK and FIDELITYBK were the most active in the subsector as 37 million units of shares worth N427.75 million were traded in 1,490 transactions. Trading in the Equities of ZENITHBANK, STERLNBANK and FIDELITYBK accounted for 80% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

Other Financial Institutions came second ahead of Banking sector. Equities of GTCO and ACCESSCORP were the most active in the subsector as 24 million units of shares worth N306.58 million were traded in 1,515 transactions. Trading in the Equities of GTCO and ACCESSCORP accounted for 62% of the total volume traded in the subsector.

NASD Market

The NASD market closed Negative after today's trading activities as the NASD Security Index (NSI) decreased by 0.69% to close at 741.25pts. Consequently, Market Capitalization closed at 975.80 billion. Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by 48.05% and value increased by 170.70%. Investors traded a total of 137,271 units of shares valued at N12.34 million in 5 deals.

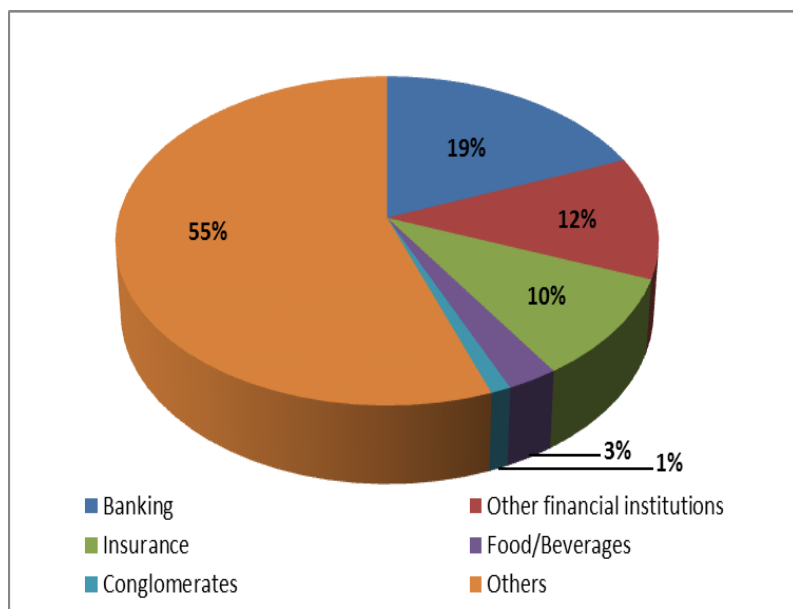
