The ASI is down by 94bps marking the fourth weekly decline.....up by 60bps today

The All Share index closed the first week of September on a bearish note down by 94bps marking the fourth weekly decline. In today's market, the local bourse (NGX) closed the day on a bullish note as ASI appreciated by 60bps driven by price appreciation and increase buying interest in all sectoral tickers. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed positively to settle at 138,980.01pts.

Market Capitalization closed positively at N87.93trillion, as investors gained N520.64billion, and Year-to-date (YtD) gain increased to 35.03%.

What shaped today's market direction

The gain in today's market can majorly be attributed to price appreciation and increase buying interest in SOVRENINS (4.21%), NB (3.79%), ZENITHBANK (1.01%) and UBA (2.19%) with offsetting losses in FIDELITYBK (-0.24%), UCAP (-3.21%), STERLINGNG (-0.66%) and CHAMPION (-4.15%) which kept the ASI in positive terrain. Gains were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks. The market breadth measured by advancers/ decliners was positive, closing at 3.58x, indicating advancers more than laggards. The top gainers include ELLAHLAKES (10%), VERITASKAP (10%), HONYFLOUR (9.95%), MANSARD (9.94%) and ROYALEX (9.94%)

Sectoral performance was positive

Sectoral performance was positive. All our observed indices closed positively due to price appreciation in all sectoral tickers. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain increased to 35.03%.

At the close of today's trade, AUSTINLAZ (-9.75%), NEIMETH (-8.33%), DAARCOMM (-4.44%), CHAMPION (-4.15%) and UNILEVER (-4.11%) were among the 12 market laggards as 124 stocks traded today.

Market activity, measured by aggregate volume, increased by 276.80%, while aggregate value depreciated by 18.73%. Investors traded a total of 1.81bn units of shares valued at N15.98bn in 24,483 deals.

The most active stocks by volume were SOVRENINS, which traded 1.41bn units, followed by NB with 41.20mn units, FIDELITYBK with 30.55mn units, ZENITHBANK with 26.35mn, and UNIVINSURE with 24.15mn units.

The most active stocks by value were **SOVRENINS**, which traded **N4.21bn**, followed by NB with N2.82bn, ZENITHBANK with N1.70bn, MTNN with N864.09mn, and FIDELITYBK with N642.12mn.
