The month of September prints a new high......the ASI appreciated by 29bps today

The bulls are getting back to the market as the ASI appreciated by **29bps** driven by price appreciation and increase buying interest in all sectoral tickers except **NGXOILGAS**. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed positively to settle at **139.796.11**.

Market Capitalization closed positively at **N88.45trillion**, as investors gained **N253.95billion**, and Year-to-date (YtD) gain increased to **35.82%**

What shaped today's market direction

The gains in today's market can majorly be attributed to price appreciation and increase buying interest in FCMB (2.38%), GTCO (0.54%), ACCESSCORP (0.78%) and ZENITHBANK (0.38%) offsetting losses in ELLAHLAKES (-8.76%), OANDO (-0.53%), TRANSCORP (-0.11%) and NGXGROUP (-1.17%) which kept the ASI in a positive terrain. Gains were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks in NGX30, NGXBNK, NGXCG, NGXINDUSTR, NGXINS. The market breadth measured by advancers/ decliners was positive closing at 1.89x, indicating more advancers than laggards The top gainers include REGALINS (10%), MECURE (9.92%), ETRANZACT (9.73%), DAARCOMM (9.57%) and DEAPCAP (9.52%).

Sectoral performance was positive

Sectoral performance was positive. All our observed indices closed positively due to increased buying interest in NGX30, NGXBNK, NGXCG, NGXINDUSTR, NGXINS except NGXOILGAS which closed negatively. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain increased to 35.82%.

At the close of today's trade, UNILEVER (-9.79%), FTNCOCOA (-9.4%), ELLAHLAKES (-8.76%), LINKASSURE (-6.85%) and BERGER (-6.33%) were among the 19 market laggards as 126 stocks traded today.

Market activity, measured by aggregate volume, decreased by **30.45%**, with aggregate value depreciating by **30.41%**. Investors traded a total of **659.16mn** units of shares valued at **N12.50bn** in **25,192** deals.

The most active stocks by volume were FCMB, which traded 202.48mn units, followed by UNIVINSURE with 63.14mn units, FIRSTHOLDCO with 44.22mn units, REGALINS with 30.98mn, and ACCESSCORP with 26.12mn units.

The most active stocks by value were **FCMB**, which traded **N2.09bn** units, followed by **GTCO** with **N1.5bn**, **FIRSTHOLDCO** with **N1.33bn**, **MTNN** with **N800.11mn**, and **ACCESSCORP** with **N676.41mn**. **SECTORAL PERFORMANCE**
