## ASI starts the week on a bullish note ..... appreciating by 86bps for the day

The Nigeria All Share Index (ASI) starts the week on a positive trajectory, in today's market, the local bourse (NGX) closed the day on a bullish note as ASI appreciated by **86bps** driven by price appreciation and increase buying interest in all sectoral tickers. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed positively to settle at **144,822.61pts**.

Market Capitalization closed positively at **N91.92trillion**, as investors gained **N786.14billion**, and Year-to-date (YtD) gain increased to **40.71%**.

### What shaped today's market direction

The gains in today's market can majorly be attributed to price appreciation and increased buying interest in **SEPLAT (10.00%)**, **GTCO (3.29%)**, **ELLAHLAKES (9.95%)** and **ZENITHBANK (1.25%)** with offsetting losses in **ARADEL (-3.09%)**, **CUSTODIAN (-0.95%)**, **ACCESSCORP (-1.89%)** and **UBA (-1.40%)** which kept the ASI in a positive terrain. gains were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINDUSTR**, **NGXINS**, and **NGXOILGAS**. The market breadth measured by advancers/decliners was positive, closing at **2.04x**, indicating more advancers than laggards. The top gainers include **MANSARD (10.00%)**, **SEPLAT (10.00%)**, **ELLAHLAKES (9.95%)**, **CHAMS (9.87%)** and **OMATEK (9.84%)**.

### Sectoral performance was positive

Sectoral performance was positive. All our observed indices closed positively due to increased buying interest in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINDUSTR**, **NGXINS**, and **NGXOILGAS**. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain increased to **40.71%**.

At the close of today's trade **INTENEGINS (-8.42%)**, **MCNICHOLS (-8.31%)**, **THOMASWY (-7.72%)**, **BERGER (-6.80%)** and **ABCTTRANS (-5.81%)** were among the **23** market laggards as **126** stocks traded today.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by **4.56%**, with aggregate value depreciating by **25.94%**. Investors traded a total of **519.90mn** units of shares valued at **N14.53bn** in **35,344** deals.

The most active stocks by volume were **ELLAHLAKES**, which traded **80.06mn**, followed by **CHAMS** with **30.21mn** units, **STERLINGNG** with **24.74mn** units, **CUSTODIAN** with **21.82mn**, and **GTCO** with **20.05mn** units.

The most active stocks by value were **GTCO**, which traded **N1.96bn**, followed by **SEPLAT** with **N1.64bn**, **ARADEL** with **N1.20bn**, **ELLAHLAKES** with **N1.18bn**, and **ZENITHBANK** with **N1.11bn**.
