The All-Share Index closed on a bullish note...appreciating by 10bps for the day

The local bourse (NGX) closed the day on a bullish note as ASI increased by **10bps** driven by price appreciation and increased buying interest in **NGX30, NGXBNK, NGXCG**. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed positively to settle at **143,763.13pts**.

Market Capitalization closed positively at **N91.6trillion**, as investors gained **N94.63billion**, and Year-to-Date (YtD) gain increased to **39.68%**.

What shaped today's market direction

The gains in today's market can majorly be attributed to price appreciation and increase buying interest in **FIRSTHOLDCO (1.47%), GTCO (1.42%), UBA (0.14%)** and **FIDELITYBK (0.26%)** offsetting losses in **ACCESSCORP (-0.48%), NEM (-2.12%), OANDO (-2.5%)** and **TRANSCORP (-1.23%)** which kept the ASI in a positive terrain. Gains were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks in **NGX30, NGXBNK, NGXCG**. The market breadth measured by advancers/ decliners was positive closing at **1.30x**, indicating more advancers than laggards. The top gainers include **NCR (9.98%), IKEJAHOTEL (9.86%), PRESTIGE (9.56%), EUNISELL (9.49%)** and **STERLINGNG (8.96%)**.

Sectoral performance was mixed

Sectoral performance was mixed. Some of our observed indices closed positively due to increase buying interest in **NGX30, NGXBNK, NGXCG** while **NGXINS, NGXOILGAS** closed negatively with **NGXINDUSTR** closing flat. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain increased to **39.68%**.

At the close of today's trade **CAVERTON (-10.00%), UNIONDICON (-10.00%), SUNUASSUR (-4.78%), LASACO (-4.58%)** and **MANSARD (-4.23%)** were among the **20** market laggards as **129** stocks traded today.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by **19.96%**, with aggregate value depreciating by **34.85%**. Investors traded a total of **556.1mn** units of shares valued at **N18.67bn** in **19,354** deals.

The most active stocks by volume were **FIRSTHOLDCO**, which traded **93.71mn**, followed by **ACCESSCORP** with **81.76mn** units, **FIDELITYBK** with **41.79mn** units, **FCMB** with **38.02mn**, and **UBA** with **31.95mn** units.

The most active stocks by value were **STANBIC**, which traded **N3.2bn**, followed by **FIRSTHOLDCO** with **N2.9bn**, **GTCO** with **N2.22bn**, **MTNN** with **N1.93bn**, and **ACCESSCORP** with **N1.68bn**.
