

# Daily Market Report



Wednesday, February 11, 2026

The market closed the day on a bullish note.....appreciating by 78bps today.

The local bourse (NGX) closed the day on a bullish note as ASI advanced by **78bps** driven by price appreciation and increased buying interest in all sectoral tickers except **NGXINDUSTR**. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed positively to settle at **178,184.54**.

Market Capitalization closed positively at **N114.37trillion**, as investors gained **N882.70billion**, and Year-to-date (YtD) gain increased to **14.50%**.

### What shaped today's market direction

The gains in today's market can majorly be attributed to price appreciation and increase buying interest in **MTNN (1.09%)**, **ZENITHBANK (2.3%)**, **GTCO (4.95%)** and **NB (1.17%)** offsetting losses in **WAPCO (-0.43%)**, **ACCESSCORP (-0.41%)**, **FIDELITYBK (-2.01%)** and **CUSTODIAN (-1.82%)** which kept the ASI in a positive terrain. Gains were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINS**, **NGXOILGAS**. The market breadth measured by advancers/ decliners was positive closing at **1.58x**, indicating more advancers than laggards. The top gainers include **CONHALLPLC (10%)**, **FTGINSURE (10%)**, **MEYER (10%)**, **NESTLE (10%)** and **CAP (9.98%)**.

### Sectoral performance was positive

Sectoral performance was positive. All our observed indices closed positively due to increase buying interest in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINS**, **NGXOILGAS** except **NGXINDUSTR** which closed negatively. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain increased to **14.50%**.

At the close of today's trade **HONYFLOUR (-9.7%)**, **NEIMETH (-9.15%)**, **TIP (-5.81%)**, **RTBRISCOE (-5.7%)** and **STERLINGNG (-5.56%)** were among the **31** market laggards as **133** stocks traded today.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by **10.57%**, with aggregate value depreciating by **30.18%**. Investors traded a total of **939.04mn** units of shares valued at **N34.00bn** in **61,047** deals.

The most active stocks by volume were **TANTALIZER**, which traded **85.32mn** units, followed by **ACCESSCORP** with **61.36mn** units, **CHAMS** with **38.59mn** units, **JAPAULGOLD** with **38.24mn** units, and **DEAPCAP** with **36.79mn** units.

The most active stocks by value were **ARADEL**, which traded **N2.98bn**, followed by **MTNN** with **N2.88bn**, **ZENITHBANK** with **N2.7bn**, **WAPCO** with **N2.43bn**, and **GTCO** with **N2.14bn**.
