The local bourse closed lower.....as the ASI declined by 57bps in today's market

In today's market, the local bourse (NGX) declined by **57bps** driven by price depreciation and profit taking in all sectoral tickers except **NGXINS**. As a result, the benchmark All Share Index (ASI) closed negatively to settle at **196,066.23**.

Market Capitalization closed negatively at **N125.85trillion**, as investors lost **N725.84billion**, and Year-to-date (YtD) gain decreased to **26.00%**.

What shaped today's market direction

The loss in today's market can majorly be attributed to price depreciation and profit taking in **OANDO (-7.59%)**, **MTNN (-2.15%)**, **GTCO (-0.85%)** and **CUSTODIAN (-3.54%)** offsetting gains in **ZENITHBANK (0.11%)**, **NGXGROUP (2.11%)**, **FIDELITYBK (0.25%)** and **JAIZBANK (0.19%)** which kept the ASI in a negative terrain. Losses were recorded in large-cap, mid-cap, and small-cap stocks in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINDUSTR**, **NGXOILGAS**. The market breadth measured by advancers/ decliners was negative closing at **0.78x**, indicating more laggards than advancers. The top gainers include **PREMPAINTS (9.97%)**, **CONOIL (9.95%)**, **SUNUASSUR (9.95%)**, **DAARCOMM (9.84%)** and **ETERNA (9.56%)**.

Sectoral performance was negative

Sectoral performance was negative. All our observed indices closed negatively due to price depreciation and profit taken in **NGX30**, **NGXBNK**, **NGXCG**, **NGXINDUSTR**, **NGXOILGAS** except **NGXINS** which closed positively. As a result, the year-to-date (YTD) gain decreased to **26.00%**.

At the close of today's trade **MBENEFIT (-10%)**, **NASCON (-10%)**, **REDSTAREX (-9.94%)**, **AUSTINLAZ (-9.88%)** and **SCOA (-9.85%)** were among the **42** market laggards as **131** stocks traded today.

Market activity measured by aggregate volume decreased by **2.06%**, with aggregate value depreciating by **10.78%**. Investors traded a total of **746.83mn** units of shares valued at **N27.84bn** in **65,135** deals.

The most active stocks by volume were **ACCESSCORP**, which traded **80.26mn** units, followed by **MBENEFIT** with **52.67mn** units, **FTGINSURE** with **41.38mn** units, **ZENITHBANK** with **35.34mn** units, and **JAIZBANK** with **31.51mn** units.

The most active stocks by value were **ZENITHBANK**, which traded **N3.29bn**, followed by **ARADEL** with **N3.26bn**, **ACCESSCORP** with **N2bn**, **OANDO** with **N1.55bn**, and **MTNN** with **N1.53bn**.
